Telescope Update

The 30 inch telescope is progressing on schedule. The Surrerier truss (open frame tube) is complete. The mirror is complete except for the optical coatings. Kevin Medlock has just finished building the vacuum chamber in which the mirror will be coated. The secondary mirror support is also complete.

The 24 inch primary drive gear has been cut, and work is progressing on both the north and south piers. The scope will be mounted on an English cross-axis mount, and will stand twelve feet high!

The 22 inch scope is in a similar state of construction. It will be mounted on a fork mount.

The Observatory Building

The FPOA has contracted with an architect to produce the architectural drawings for the 30 inch telescope building. The building will be a temporary structure, roughly 20 feet on a side, with a sliding roof. Once the drawings are complete, we will be able to generate a list of materials required.

Anyone out there who has a lead on building materials like concrete, nails,

plywood, 2 x 4's, etc, please give us a call! Anyone wishing to help in construction, likewise let us know. We plan to start the actual construction either in late June or early July.
